

Back to the matter at hand...

Why is science so afraid of competing theories that they refuse to even talk about them? (They are afraid of confronting the God of creation)

For that matter, why throughout history have we tried to purge the things we don't like or don't want to remember? (we are afraid of confronting our own reality: our sinful nature).

In the end, it comes down to questions that cannot be answered by science, philosophy, history (though history does provide evidence of the answer), and the like: Humanity is flawed and sinful.

Until we are willing to confront this reality as a species, we will continue to reject both Biblical history as well as our own history.

There is abundant evidence to support both the Biblical Creation account (a “literal” 6 day creation/young earth approach), as well as the reality of Noah’s Ark and the global flood. Jesus even refers to the flood as historical fact (Matthew 24:37-39; Luke 17:26-7). Creationists do not fear the “scientific” explanation as though it could somehow “undo” or invalidate the creation account – it’s why they present both sides for everyone.

When the foundation is cut out, the entire Bible becomes a house of cards that can easily be dismissed.

When history is cut out, we easily and quickly repeat the mistakes of history, rather than confront and struggle against human reality. WE CEASE BEING ONE NATION UNDER GOD.

"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free (from sin, death, and the devil).... . . . But do not use your freedom to indulge the sinful nature; rather, serve one another in love." (Galatians 5:1, 5:13)

Recognizing the basic attributes of the universe is what is truly needed today: Truths about God, Original Sin, the Son of God, and Justification by Faith.
