The Museum Of Bad Art (MOBA) is dedicated to art in which something has gone wrong. Since 1993, they have collected art from thrift stores, yard sales, sidewalk trash, and even the artists who create it. They analyze, compare to classic art, and share with thousands of fans around the world. With tongue-in-cheek commentary and a light-hearted attitude, MOBA shows that art and art museums can be fun. In this "Dopplehangers" program, Michael Frank, the curator of MOBA, will present art that, intentionally or not, resembles famous people.

1620: The First Year

Monday, November 14th at 6:30pm



In 2020, the 400th Anniversary of the landing of the Pilgrims came but was overshadowed by the Covid Pandemic. There were no celebrations or commemoration ceremonies marking this event in our

history. This was a time of great difficulty for most Americans. In 1620, the Pilgrims also faced adversity. They came seeking religious freedom and found an untamed inhospitable wilderness fraught with innumerable dangers. Mr. Christopher Daley will examine the difficult voyage over the Atlantic and the decision to land on Cape Cod, focus on the beginnings of Plymouth Colony (with a short discussion on the history of "Plymouth Rock") and recount the early scant encounters with the Wampanoag people.
