

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING CONNECTIONS
TO WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS
OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE, INDIANA
AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE,
INDIANA:

SECTION ONE: That no further or additional connections to
the water or sewer systems of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana
shall be made until the sanitary sewer system of the Town is
rehabilitated and placed in a functioning condition.

SECTION TWO: That any person, firm, corporation or business
desiring to attach any building, home or other structure to the
water or sewer systems of the Town of Cloverdale, Indiana must
apply to the Clerk-Treasurer of said Town and receive approval
for such connection from the Town Board.

SECTION THREE: That any person, firm, corporation or business
violating any provisions of this Ordinance, upon conviction, shall
be fined not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than
Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each violation.

SECTION FOUR: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after its passage and legal publication and that
all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are
hereby repealed.
