Entry Requirements: This is a doubles team bowling tournament operated by the Ohio High School Bowling Program through the Youth Bowler's Tournament Association. This tournament is open to any 2016-2017 Ohio 9th-12th grade high school student. **A bowler does NOT have to be a member of a high school bowling team to participate in this tournament.**

Tournament Organization: These Championships will be conducted on Sat., April 29, 2017 at the Columbus Square Bowling Palace, 5707 Forest Hills Blvd., Columbus, OH 43231. There will be 2 squads allowing for multiple participation. See the tournament schedule (pg. 3) for squad times. There will be three (3) separate divisions: a boys division, a girls division, and a mixed division. A bowler may team with any partner in any grade from the same or different Ohio high school but may not bowl with the same partner twice. A bowler may bowl in both squads, if desired. Each entry requires a separate entry fee. Walk-in's will be accepted subject to lane availability.

Tournament Format: All teams in each division will bowl ten (10) games of Baker-format bowling, with an entire team game bowled on the same lane, switching lanes on their pair after each game, and with the team moving pairs after each two (2) games. Bowlers may choose their line-up (order of bowling) prior to the start of any game with one team member bowling the odd numbered frames (1,3,5,7,9) and the other team member bowling the even numbered frames (2,4,6,8,10) in a game. There will be no step-ladder or final elimination rounds. All scoring will be conducted on a scratch (actual) basis.

Team Entry Fee: \$80.00. Breakdown: Lineage & expenses: \$45.00. SMART Scholarships: \$35.00. Walk-in team entry fee: add \$10.00 late registration team fee (not charged for bowlers from 1st shift who decide on-site to bowl the 2nd shift. Subject to lane availability). The closing date for entries is the date of bowling.

Awards: The 1st place team in each division will receive medals. No fewer than 1:6 teams in each division will be awarded SMART scholarships with 50% of the team scholarship awarded to each team member. Final results will be posted on ohiohighschoolbowling.com.

Dress Code/Behavior: A sleeved shirt is required. Bowlers may also wear Doubles Championship T-shirts (available for sale at tournament). Dress pants or walking shorts for boys or girls are allowed. Shorts/skirts subject to "fingertip-length" standards. No jeans, pants with outside pockets, or hats allowed. Bowlers are expected to be professional in appearance, reflecting the high caliber of tournament bowling anticipated. Abuse of equipment, foul or disruptive language/gestures, and/or unprofessional behavior by bowlers or spectators are cause for the non-refundable dismissal from participation or attendance at this tournament. All bowling equipment must meet USBC specifications. The use of powder, rosin bags, or any foreign substance (including Easy Slide) on shoes, the approach, the facility floor, or on bowling balls is not permitted. Only participating bowlers and officials are permitted in the bowling area.

Empowerment: The Tournament Manager has the right to refuse any entry. The bowler, by voluntary participation in this tournament, acquiesces to the final authority of the Tournament Manager to interpret and enforce all tournament rules, regulations, and procedures. Any unforeseen or not described situation will be regulated by USBC rules with interpretive judgment guided by the best interests of youth bowling and this event.

Scholarship Management: 100% of all collected scholarship funds will be awarded and sent to the USBC SMART Program for management/dispersal. Account #11600. SMART Program info available on bowl.com.
