1897-1992

Charles G. Simms, age 94 of Sand Point, passed away Tuesday, Feb. 11 at Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe.

He was born Dec. 19, 1897 in Detroit Lakes, MN., son of the late William and Sophia (Halverson) Simms. He was united in marriage to Dorothy June Hanan on Oct. 26, 1927 in Oregon, WI.

Mr. Simms was a mechanical engineer, graduating from the university of Minnesota. While at the university he enlisted in SATC United States Army and was discharged in December 1918. Upon graduation he worked for the Wisconsin Public Service, Oshkosh, WI. In the mid-1920's he began employment as an automotive engineer with A C Spark Plug, Flint, retiring in 1962 after 36 years of service. He and his wife retired to Sand Point.

Through the years he was a member of the General Motors Executive Club, the Flint Ski Club, the Sun Valley Ski Club, the Hidden Valley Ski Club, the Power Squadron and the Scenic Golf and Country Club.

He is survived by his wife, Dorothy J., Pigeon and a niece, Mrs. James (Patricia) McGuown, Tucson, AZ.

Funeral services were conducted Friday, Feb. 14 at 3 p.m. from Meyersieck-Bussema Funeral Home, Pigeon. Rev. Robert von Oeye, pastor of Harbor Beach First Presbyterian Church officiated with burial in the Caseville Twp. Cemetery.
