The Native Land Conservancy, Inc. was founded in 2012 in Mashpee MA and received tax-exempt status as a 501c3 non-profit land conservation trust in 2013. We have created a Native-run land conservation group for the purposes of: protecting sacred lands, natural and cultural resources, and encouraging the continuation of Native American traditional lifeways of the Northeast. The NLC's mission is to preserve and protect the natural and cultural resources, habitats, ecosystems and archaeological sites of lands located in the Eastern MA region. We are the first native-led land trust east of the Mississippi River. We wish to partner with other local and regional land conservancies to preserve and provide tribal wisdom to the land management of rescued properties. We are grateful for a start-up grant for operations from the Fields Pond Foundation in MA. including other generous donations from like-minded individuals. We joined The Compact of Cape Cod Conservation Trusts, Inc. in 2014 to learn from other established land trusts and Compact staff about their land conservation techniques.
