On this day April 29th in Civil War history:

- *1862 Union troops officially took possession of New Orleans after the surrender of Fort Jackson and Fort St. Phillip.
- Union Admiral David Farragut began capturing the city on April 25.
- 1863 Union Colonel Abel Streight's command was attacked by troops under the command of General Nathan Bedford Forrest.

 *On this day, the Union had set a trap and held the Confederates under fire and wounded Captain William Forrest (Nathan Bedford's brother).
