

Message from State Rep. Jennifer Webb, District 69

The following is an email reprinted with permission from Rep. Jennifer Webb on May 27, 2020.

Dear Friends,

The county, local cities, and our communities have done an amazing job supporting our families and small businesses. Pinellas County's "Pinellas Cares" program has been directly supporting families and businesses by paying bills like rent/mortgage, utilities, and car payments. The payments are up to \$3,000 per family and up to \$5,000 per business. Families can text "covid cares" to 898-211 for the documentation required to apply for the program. Businesses can apply to Economic Development Council. While the county's program supporting families will remain open, June 1 is the deadline for the small business portion of the Pinellas County Covid-19 program.

My staff and I are also working to set up a Zoom meeting with the Director of CareerSource Pinellas to discuss how she and her staff can assist our residents with unemployment compensation questions and with assistance with returning to work. Look for that event by checking my Facebook events.

Please like my Legislative Facebook Page. You will receive breaking updates on the our state's response to COVID-19, resources to help you during this crisis, and invitations to Legislative Town Halls.




DHCA's next general membership meeting is Tuesday, Oct. 13 at 6:30 pm (social time) with the meeting starting promptly at 7 p.m.
