Subj: NDIA Violates Its Mission Statement by Advocating SAE/EIA-748E Earned Value Management System, Part 2

Dear Hon. NDIA Pres. David Norquist:

This letter augments letter dated September 16. It cites the following documents:

- 2. White paper, Subj: Integrating the Embedded Software Path, Model-Based Systems Engineering, MOSA, and Digital Engineering with Program Management, dated September 16, 2025.

#### Excerpts from letter to USD Michael:

Note: This revision cites the guidebook, *Implementing a Modular Open Systems Approach* (MOSA) *in Department of Defense Programs*, February 2025. The guide provides best practices for planning, implementing, and evaluating MOSA. Best practices include using metrics that measure progress and achievement of MOSA objectives, implementation activities, and risk mitigations and using digital engineering (DE) practices necessary to capture, assess, and support MOSA elements.

#### 7. Adopt DE Practices:

• Use *DE practices* necessary to capture, assess, and support MOSA elements in product development to promote modularity and openness using data and models throughout the life cycle.

The draft SAE/EIA-748E is silent on the MOSA best practices or metrics in addition to its failure to address other engineering best practices such as DE and systems engineering.

As requested in the Part 1 letter to you:

#### The NDIA should:

- 1. Withdraw its submittal to the SAE International G-47 SE Committee and
- 2. Submit any draft EVMS standard, with best business practices for EVM, to an appropriate approving organization such as the Project Management Institute or ISO. Failure to do so would be a violation of NDIA's mission statement and would disqualify EIA-748 from being a Voluntary Consensus Standard (VCS) per OMB criteria.
