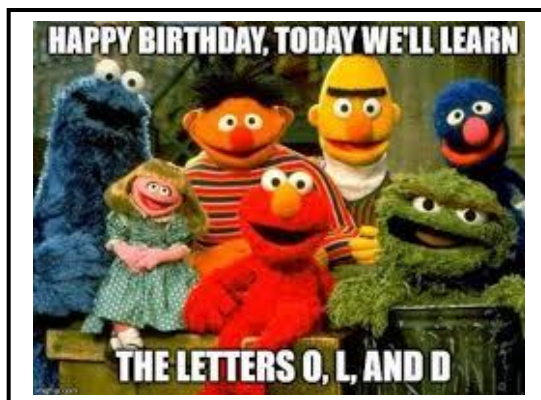

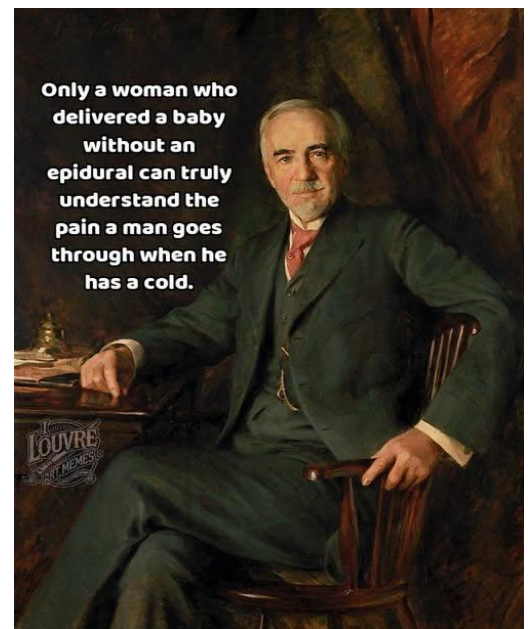

# How to avoid Auto Theft

## CAA Insurance

**THOUSANDS OF VEHICLES** in Canada are stolen annually, continuing to raise serious concerns for car owners. “Auto theft has decreased nationally by about 17 percent, but it’s still a major issue,” says Bryan Gast, vice-president of investigative services at Équité Association. This not-for-profit is the national authority on insurance crime and fraud prevention representing the property and casualty insurance industry. Ontario and Quebec remain hotbeds for theft, but rates are rising in Alberta, where high-end vehicles like the Jeep Wrangler and Lexus RX Series are now prime targets. Sophisticated keyless entry systems have created a vulnerability that’s being exploited by modern-day car thieves. Called relay theft, the electronic signal from your car’s fob can be captured, providing access to your automobile, no key required. Vehicles are no longer stolen for joy rides or chop shops, but for export or resale, notes Gast. The good news? A layered approach can help deter thieves. CAA Insurance offers these recommendations:

- **Secure your parked vehicle with a wheel lock, brake pedal lock or steering wheel lock (e.g., The Club).**
  - **Secure your car key fob by storing it in a Faraday box or pouch to prevent signal hacking.**
- **Consider a professionally installed after-market immobilizer — an electronic device that prevents a car from starting without the correct key or transponder. Certain immobilizers make it almost impossible to steal your car.**
  - **Lock your doors (both car and home) and park your car inside if you have a garage.**
    - **Enable or install multi-factor authentication capabilities in your vehicle.**
    - **If you own multiple vehicles, park the less valuable one closer to the street.**
  - **Install motion sensors and a camera on your driveway to capture any activity.**
  - **Cover the vehicle identification number (VIN), so it’s not visible on the dashboard.**
    - **Store a GPS tracker (e.g., AirTag) to track your vehicle should it be stolen.**
    - **Ensure items are out of sight and do not leave valuables in your car.**
    - **Always avoid leaving your vehicle unattended while it is running.**
- **CAA Insurance urges individuals to report any suspicious activity to police and avoid confrontation with thieves.**

**Do not attempt to recover your stolen vehicle yourself, warns Gast. Contact law enforcement instead. And although auto theft may never be eliminated entirely, a few preventative steps can still drastically reduce the risk of your vehicle being stolen.**

## Wheel and Brake Dust Info

*Thank you for sharing your experience with your fellow readers. Yes, buying high-quality aftermarket wheels is certainly a solution to the pervasive problems with OEM wheels, but many C7 owners remain understandably unhappy about the position they find themselves in. Some want to maintain their car's original appearance and configuration, while others simply resent having to spend a significant amount of money to fix a problem that should never have escaped the factory.*

*It is, of course, possible to pay considerably less for new aftermarket wheels than you spent on your Crays, and for some owners that's a suitable compromise between staying with the problem-prone OEM rims and buying high-end forged units.*

**Busting Dust**

My 2017 Z51 has just under 13,000 miles, and I love driving it when it is sunny and warm here in Texas. The only thing I take issue with is the brake dust that deposits itself on my black wheels. I'll wash the car and polish the wheels with Griot's ceramic polish, go for a drive, and return home to find that the rims already have a fresh coating of dust. I keep the car covered in the garage when it's parked, so it always looks great when I take it out—except for the wheels.

I've heard that ceramic brake pads could be an answer to the dusting issue and would like your opinion. Assuming they're a good idea, do I have to swap out the rotors at the same time? Also, how will ceramic brakes change the car's braking characteristics? Is there another solution?

*You can stick with your original rotors if they are in excellent condition, and simply change from OEM pads to carbon-ceramic-compound pads. This*

*should dramatically reduce the amount of brake dust produced during normal street driving. Numerous companies, including Power Stop, Carbotech, and Hawk sell them. I do recommend that you choose a pad compound specifically engineered for ordinary street driving, and not for racing or track days. With a ceramic street compound, you will experience little to no difference in the pedal feel and stopping ability of your Corvette as compared with the OEM pads.*

### Car Search

I am trying to locate a 1964 coupe that my father-in-law built for me. Because the VIN wasn't in the format it is in today, it's difficult to find the car. Any ideas?

# How to get rid of brake dust

Upgrading to a high-quality ceramic brake pad will limit the amount of brake dust your car produces. But if you don't feel like swapping out your pads—or at least not yet—there are other preventative measures to consider.

For instance, there are aerosol brake dust repellents you can buy. Although some people swear by these products, how well they actually work is up for debate. If you're in the market, Hot Rod magazine recommends the repellant from Armor All.

There are also rim dust shields (also known as brake dust covers) that mount between your car's rim and wheel hub. The problem is, because the covers modify your car, there's always the chance they could affect vehicle performance and safety.

Our take is this—skip the aftermarket dust shields altogether. If you're going to go to the trouble of taking off your wheels, you might as well upgrade your brakes to ceramic pads. Replacing semi-metallic brakes with a set of ceramic pads is a proven way to reduce brake dust.

## Cleaning your Wheels

Be sure your wheels are cool before you begin cleaning. Also, if possible, park your car out of direct sunlight. You'll want to clean one wheel at a time by doing the following:

1. Use the hose (with the spray nozzle attached) to rinse off the wheel.
2. Apply the wheel cleaner according to the instructions on the package.  
Note: Different types of wheels have different finishes (i.e., aluminum, painted, etc.). Be sure to select the correct type of cleaner for your wheels. Otherwise, you could do more harm than good.
3. Rinse the wheel to remove the cleaner.
4. Mix the car wash soap and water together inside the bucket.
5. Dip the wash mitt into the bucket, then use the mitt to scrub away any remaining brake dust.
6. If that doesn't do the trick, you can try cleaning the dust off with a soft-bristled brush. Do not use a stiff-bristled brush, as it can damage your wheels. Selecting a brush that's designed specifically for wheel cleaning is a safe bet.
7. Rinse the wheel to remove the car wash soap.
8. Dry the wheel with a clean towel.
9. Apply the wheel polish according to the instructions on the package. Once again, be sure to select the correct type of cleaner for your wheel finish.

Sunday April 27th

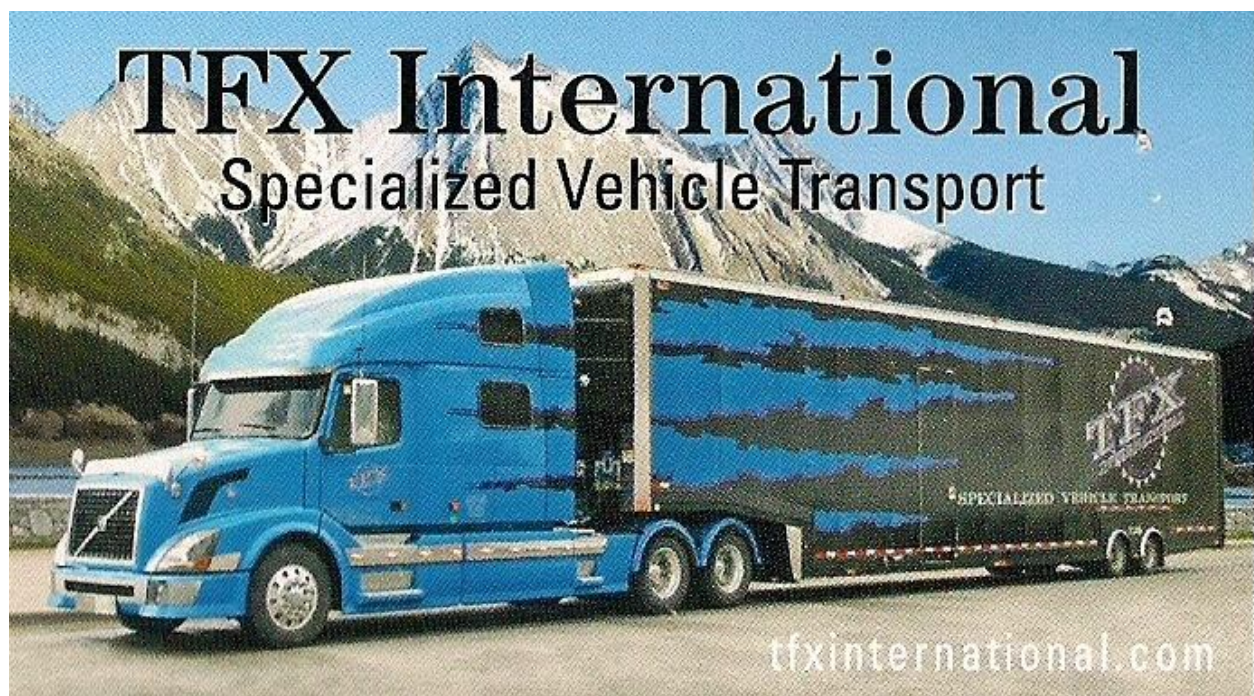

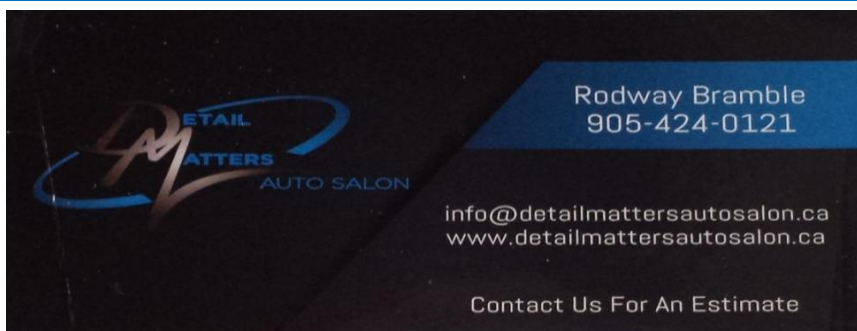

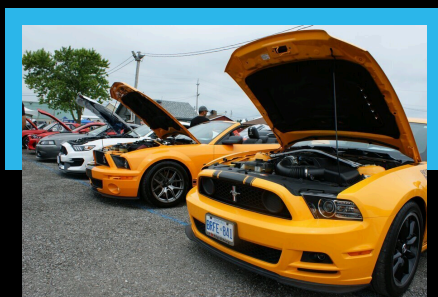
