You will have time to explore the shops and have lunch on your own. One of the most unique attractions at Navy Pier is the Smith Museum of Stained Glass Windows. There are over 150 stained glass windows on display that provide a wonderful insight into Chicago's cultural, ethnic and artistic history. Make sure you take in the 13 windows that highlight the work of Louis Comfort Tiffany and were actually in his studio in New York City. This afternoon we'll enjoy a guided tour of the wonderful Ethnic Neighborhoods of Chicago. You'll see and hear all about the German, Polish, Italian, Irish, Swedish, Asian and Hispanic neighborhoods including some special stops. Later we'll stop for an included dinner prior to heading to the Theater District for our evening Broadway Musical (show to be announced). We'll then return to the hotel. (B, D)



Day 3: Following included breakfast we'll visit the John G. Shedd Aquarium. You'll have time to enjoy their wonderful Aquarium and the Oceanarium exhibits and to enjoy lunch on your own. This afternoon we'll head to the "" and Michigan Avenue for time to browse the stores. Next we'll look at Alphonse Capone's Chicago as we enjoy a special "Untouchables" guided tour en-



route to , a Roaring Twenties Speakeasy for included dinner and their musical comedy show. "Da mugs and da dolls" will sing, dance and entertain you with some wonderful music selections from Cole Porter, George Gershwin, Fats Waller, Duke Ellington and more. We'll then return to the hotel. (B, D)

Day 4: After an included breakfast we'll head north back into Wisconsin stopping for a morning break, lunch break on your own and an afternoon break en-route back to the Twin Cities.
