#### **7 WAYS TO NURTURE FAMILY VALUES & RELATIONSHIPS:**

- **Practice Unconditional Love:** Show love to your family members, not based on their actions, but based on their intrinsic value as God's creation.
- **Teach and Uphold Respect:** Teach children the importance of respecting authority, starting with parental authority, as this is a reflection of our respect for God's authority.
- Nurture Faith: Cultivate an environment where faith is openly discussed and practiced, encouraging each family member in their personal relationship with Christ.
- **Promote Honesty and Transparency:** Encourage open communication and honesty within the family, fostering trust and intimacy.
- Instil the Value of Service: Teach children the importance of serving others, following the model of Jesus who came "not to be served, but to serve."
- Maintain Forgiveness and Grace: Promote a culture of forgiveness in the family, reflecting God's forgiveness towards us.
- **Pray Together:** Make prayer a regular part of your family life, strengthening your collective reliance on God.
