



## Zoom Meeting Minutes January 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Motion to approve the minutes of December 2<sup>nd</sup> passed by voice vote.

Zoom meetings will be held for this winter season, Todd is running the zoom link.

Bank Balance is \$16,803.40. We are still waiting for the state grant money to arrive.

State is funding the grooming costs this winter at a 50/50 split with the club. We have approval for 279 hours of grooming at \$115/hour.

Grooming update:

Installing new signs for parking at Marina lot

Forest service signs are up at the Quarry lot. They direct overflow parking to the Marina and credits the grooming of the trails by the snow club.

Before the groomer broke down, Larry and Mark got the 42 road groomed. Still lack snow cover at lower elevations to use the tiller safely.

Cat is waiting for new parts to arrive. Larry and Mark will install them by Friday. Hope to be grooming by the week end. Stan, Larry, Mark, Mike, and Kaleb have been hired as groomers by the state.

The county road and bridge department cannot guarantee plowing to the upper lot on a regular basis. The commissioners are tasking the road department to try to keep the road open to the upper lot. We are still trying to resolve the plowing of the lot. Todd K is worried about having snowmobile access up the 550 road if it is plowed. Thursday is a meeting with the Routt County Round Table.

Vintage snowmobile race this week end at the marina parking lot. Clark Store and City Market will donate some food for our fund raiser. We will start serving at 10:00 AM.

Trail marking is still waiting for more snow to hold the poles up.
