- If you have met the Duties Of Membership you will be voted to be a Full Member.

DUTIES OF MEMBERSHIP

Members are the Society's most valuable resource. They share their knowledge and experience with others and volunteer their time.

It is an expectation that members:

- Be in agreement with our club philosophy, mission, and bi-laws.
- Regularly attend and participate in general membership meetings, committee meetings, and activities and be involved in our group.
- Commit your time and effort to Society and committee goals, attend the majority of meetings, fundraising events, projects, programs, etc.
- Be generous and willing to share your knowledge with others.
- Serve on at least one committee.
- Provide suggestions for Society activities and events.
- Keep your membership current and pay dues in a timely manner.
- Notify an officer prior to an event or meeting to let them know if you will be unable to attend.
- Conduct yourself to be a credit to the Society.
- Love daylilies!
- If an Associate Member does not put forth an effort to fulfill their Society obligations, it will be brought to the Board of Directors for review.

TYPE OF MEMBERSHIPS

- **Individual memberships** are considered to be one adult person joining the club.
- **Family memberships** are adult members of a family living at the same residence, who will receive a single copy of all Society information. Each member in a family is entitled to a single vote in elections, for motions, and is eligible for Society benefits as an individual member.
- **Charter members** are the founders of the society.
- **Associate members** will remain so for a period of one calendar year. After that time, they may pursue full membership. Associate members are not eligible to vote but are encouraged to voice their opinions and make suggestions. Associate Members participate in club trips, awards, and all events.
- **Full members** receive all club benefits and privileges, vote on issues, and are eligible to run for election.
- **Honorary membership** recognizes distinguished leaders who have made significant contributions to the world of daylilies, support our educational activities, offer plants donations when able, and share common interests with our club.

DUES

- The cost of individual full membership is \$10.
- The cost of family full membership is \$15.
- Membership is renewed annually, and dues are to be paid by January 1st of the new year.

- Associate members do not pay dues.
- At the time an associate member becomes a full member payment of dues applies.

GENERAL MEETINGS

- Regular Society meetings are held once a month with the exception of June, July, and August.
- Meetings currently take place on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:30 PM.

Other than annual membership dues we do not ask our members for financial support. We fund our club through the sale of donated plants to the general public.

In addition, we help members have beautiful daylily gardens with a variety of forms and colors by sharing plants with club members. Associate Members are encouraged to participate in garden trips and all club events.
