

Aloe grenadensis - “Popcorn Aloe”

But try thinking of any variety that comes to mind having rich, verdant green leaves- and is the size of a nice medium sized flax (Phormium, except its leaves don't get ugly with age). Imagine a green aloe that never grows into bush form, but clumps from the base, upright, to 2 ½ ft. tall.
