

Arnold Warner Russell, 79, of Caseville, formerly of Elkton, died Sunday, October 29, 2017 at his home while under hospice care.

Arnie was born August 4, 1938 in Detroit to the late William and Helen (Smith) Russell. He graduated from Elkton High School in 1957 and then entered the US Air Force. He moved to Los Angeles, California and while there met and married Claren K. "Dede" Knowles on August 3, 1968. They returned to Elkton in 1976.
