Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: Châteauneuf-du-Pape
- Soil Type: Molasse seabed of the Miocene period covered by diluvial alpine deposits (rolled pebbles), contributing to the wine's complexity and minerality.
- **Viticulture Practices**: The estate practices organic and biodynamic farming to maintain soil health and biodiversity.



Winemaking

- Harvest: Handpicked in small cases with careful selection.
- **Vinification:** Pneumatic pressing, settling of the juice, and fermentation in 30% oak barrels and 70% tanks. Aged for 8 months before bottling.

- **Appearance:** A truly sumptuous, brilliant gold hue.
- Aroma: Intensely complex with ripe fruit and delicate floral notes.
- Palate: Offers a magnificently delicate and refined texture with graceful yet powerful aromas and extraordinary length.
