Rev. Harold D. Oeschger, 80, a retired minister of the Albright United Methodist Church, passed away Sunday, May 10 in a local hospital of St. Petersburg. He was born in Bay Port.

A St. Petersburg minister since moving to Florida in 1948, Rev. Oeschger started at the church when it was known as First Evangelical United Brethren Church. Due to ill health, he was inactive for the past 12 years. He received his degree from the Evangelical Theological Seminary in Naperville, Ill. in 1932. He has served in churches in Erie, Howell and Detroit.

Oeschger is survived by his wife Rose; two daughters, Carol Lee Keen, Bartow and Donna B. Wagner, Lombard, Ill.; a brother Olin E., Mount Clemens and 10 grandchildren.
