Member of the Month - Troy & Yvonne Pyles

I went to a ranch outside of Reno, NV in October 1991 to look at a '54 Corvette advertised for sale. It turned out the owner had quite a few other cars inside his barn and outside. I saw this '63 fuelie in the barn mostly disassembled and found he had not worked on it for 7 years. I figured he'd never get it finished. Still he did not want to sell it.





I was particularly interested in the 63 because it was fuel injected and thus quite valuable compared to carbureted mid-year Corvettes. The original red on red colors were also attractive.

On the way home I developed a strategy of making a lump sum offer for both cars. I called him and closed the deal to buy the '54 and '63 as a package. I put the 54 in storage, took some parts off of it to use on another 54 of mine, and sold the car unrestored.





Over the course of the next year I worked on restoring the '63 practically every

day. Finally it was done in October 1992 just in time for us to drive it to San Diego where we were moving.

This very early 1963 Corvette has a convertible top and an optional red removable hardtop. The 360 horsepower option, 4 speed transmission, competition clutch, and 4:11 gears in the differential indicate someone ordered this car for fast acceleration. A street racer perhaps. The other options are power windows, whitewall tires and signal seeking AM radio (which I have replaced with a late '63 AM/FM).

I built the car as a driver, not a show car. Nevertheless it has won an award in every show entered. It is retired now, the dust collecting trophies have been tossed out and I don't intend to show the car again.
