The Commission was updated on the new emergency sirens. Santa Rosa & Weatherby sirens are installed. All sirens will come online at one time after installation.

Presiding Commissioner, Kyle Carrol reported on the ongoing improvements at the DeKalb Daviess Regional Jail. The Commission was also briefed on the potential costs of a failure of the old plumbing system and the jail boards desire to consider new construction in the future.

County Clerk, Melissa Meek advised she will attend a NW Clerk's meeting on Friday the 23rd in Albany.
