

# enCompass: A Comprehensive Course on Navigating Addiction

Thank you for participating in enCompass, Addiction Policy Forum's interactive, 8-hour training program that teaches participants about the science of addiction and equips them with the knowledge and tools to understand and address addiction. Like CPR, the course is designed to build the skills to support and respond to someone who needs help.

## PROGRAM IMPACT

The evaluation of the enCompass curriculum was conducted by the University of Delaware and measured addiction knowledge, confidence in how to respond to a substance use disorder (SUD), and levels of stigma, including stereotypes, prejudice and discrimination. Results show that for enCompass participants:



Knowledge about addiction increased across the board for all participants, with the greatest improvement among people that entered the training knowing the least about addiction.



Stigma decreased for all participants, with the greatest decrease among people that entered the training knowing the least about addiction.



Confidence in how to respond to a substance use disorder (SUD) increased for all participants, including how to help a loved one engage in treatment and recovery support.
