Budget Review

- \$52,000 actual/\$49,000 budgeted
- Over budget income +\$16,000
- \$23,115 balance in account at end of January/Some Bearathon monies to spend

Bearathon Distribution of Funds

- Step 1 – deduct from total all costs
- Step 2 – Teachers submit wish lists, wishes up to 70%, remaining funds for Spring Fling
- Step 3 - \$5,000 reserved for PTSO operating expenses the following year
- Step 4 – Final Distribution of Funds, previously voted to add Chromebooks to MS
- Discussion – what to do for teachers who don't have homerooms and cannot raise funds, such as music program.
- Elisa proposes using the reserved monies for next year to fill the gap.
