The unique needs of the confused resident are met at Schulenburg Regency in the Special Care Wing, a self-contained area of the center that includes a nursing staff trained specifically to monitor the needs of these patients.

While round-the-clock supervision is provided on this wing, emphasis is placed on giving our Special Care residents a great deal of freedom.

They are allowed to roam freely throughout the wing, as well as outside into an enclosed, secure courtyard. And, although the Special Care Wing has its own dining room and day room, we encourage these residents to have interaction with residents in the other wings of the center.

We believe giving these residents this kind of freedom - rather than confining them - meets their needs more fully and consequently helps them lead happier, more complete lives.

We also recognize, however, the need to ensure that our residents have a safe, secure environment while they roam. Our highly sophisticated Wander Guard security system helps provide the necessary protection, sounding a warning to the staff at any time a resident passes through a door leading to an unsecured area.

Another special feature of our Special Care Wing is a Refreshment Center, located in the day room and supplied with juices, fruits, ice cream and other goodies needed by these patients to maintain their strength.
