Call to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 pm

Clinton County Sheriff Report – None

CAASA Report – Supervisor Thelen gave a report that the ambulance service is requesting to the entities the raise of \$3.00 per capita resulting in a raise to \$6.00 per capita. Their expenses are going up, revenue from insurance companies; Medicare and Medicaid are going down.

Reading and Approval of prior month's minutes – Roof motion seconded by Kindel to dispense with the reading of the minutes and to approve the prior months minutes, motion carried.

Treasurer Report and Approval of Bill Payments - The report was approved with a motion from Graham and seconded by Kindel motion carried. Bills were approved with the exception of the brush spraying billed from the Clinton County Road Commission in the amount of \$2723.13 total bills paid were \$62,183.38 motion to pay by Kindel seconded by Graham motion carried.

County Commissioner – Washburn absent Supervisor Thelen stated he had heard that there was going to be a millage on the ballot for the 911

Assessor Botke - New construction permits are being assessed. New building permits are up.

Road Commission Meeting – November 7th at 1:00 pm this meeting is for determination of projects for the 2020 year. Kinley Rd done, gravel is done, cross tube on Silvers Rd. needs to be replaced (5' diameter) approx. \$16,000. Graham and Kindel stated the replacement tube should not be more than \$10,000.00. Grant for Colony Road will not be determined until February 2020.

Bids on Shed was brought off table with a motion by Kindel seconded by Graham motion carried. There will be one built at supervisor Thelen's and then transported to back to the Town hall.

New Bid on Sidewalk - K Pettigrew \$3675.00 Motion by Kindel seconded by Graham. This will be done in the spring because of the weather. There will also be a need for another handicap parking spot.

Zoning Case ZC – 16-19 VR Jim Burnham Farm, request for a variance to be able to split acres which can be only sold as a contiguous parcel, board support whatever zoning decides.
