1906-1996

Mayme W. Mainhart, 90 of Elkton, passed away Thursday morning, July 18, at the Four Seasons Health Care Center in Bad Axe.

She was born May 31, 1906 in Austria to the late Joseph and Mary (Sebastian) Focht. Mrs. Mainhart moved to Michigan in her youth. On Sept. 30, 1922, she was united in marriage to Adolph (Eddie) Mainhart in Bad Axe. He preceded her in death July 15, 1982.
