SPECIAL CONDITIONS (continued)

2 The opening bill for metered service, except upon conversion from flat rate service, shall be the established annual service charge for the service. Where Initial service is established after the first day of any year, the portion of such annual charge applicable to the current year shall be determined by multiplying the annual charge by one three hundred-sixty-fifth (1/365) of the number of dates remaining in the calendar year. The balance of the payment of the initial annual charge shall be credited against the charges for the succeeding annual period. If the service is not continued for at least one year after the date of Initial service, no refund of the Initial annual charge shall be due the customer.

3 All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.

4 A percentage surcharge of 6.55% will be applied to both the Quantity Rate and Service Charges above for a period of 36 months from the effective date of Advice Letter 50 A until an overall revenue shortfall of \$95,400. is recovered.

5 A \$3.18 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of three years.

6 A \$1.44 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Water Quality Balancing Account. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of three years.

7 A monthly bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the undercollection of revenue from June 17, 2014 to March 26, 2015. The amount of the surcharge is as follows: (N)

For 1 inch meter	\$ 0.53	
For 1½ inch meter	6.79	
For 2 inch meter	13.78	
For 4 inch meter	51.60

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

- 3 The annual flat rate charge applies to service during the 12-month period commencing January 1 and is due in advance. If a permanent resident of the area has been a customer of the utility for at least 12 months, the customer may elect, at the beginning of the calendar year, to pay prorated flat rate charges and surcharges in advance at intervals of less than one year (monthly, bimonthly or quarterly) in accordance with the utility's established billing periods. A nonpermanent resident may elect to pay the annual charge in two equal installments. Where such a resident has failed to pay the first half of the annual charge due January 1, service will not be restored until the total annual charge has been paid.

- 4 The opening bill for flat rate service shall be the established annual flat rate charge for the service. Where initial service is established after the first day of any year, the portion of such annual charge applicable to the current year shall be determined by multiplying the annual charge by one three-hundred-sixty-fifth (1/365) of the number of dates remaining in the calendar year. The balance of the payment of the initial annual charge shall be credited against the charges for the succeeding annual period. If the service is not continued for at least one year after the date of initial service, no refund of the initial annual charge shall be due the customer.

- 5 All bills are subject to the reimbursement fee set forth in Schedule No. UF.

- 6 A \$3.18 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Purchased Water Balancing Account. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of three years.

- 7 A \$1.44 bill surcharge shall be applied to each customer's monthly water bill to amortize the Water Quality Balancing Account. The surcharge shall be separately identified on each bill and in place for a period of three years.

- 8 A percentage surcharge of 9.02% will be applied to the Flat Rates above for a period of 36 months from the effective date of Advice Letter 59 until \$189,300 of undercollected revenue per Res. W-5026 is collected. (N)
