# **SKMHTA Feedback Survey Results**

Overall results very positive. A few comments about trees/branches down, dirty fire pits. Most negative comments were in regards to dirty or malfunctioning bathrooms/pit toilets (great reason to try to keep the camp host staffed!) Suggestions to have more signage at kiosks explaining the "one way" signs for new visitors unaware those are for snowmobiles, not horses. **More electric sites with corrals, more fun events desired!** 

### **Equipment for Obstacle Course Upkeep**

Shall the club donate towards or purchase lawn maintenance equipment? After discussion, Dawn H, who has already donated \$500 from ApDRAW for this topic, declared that ApDRAW is closing down after many years, and will use some of the funds to provide NEW (warranted) equipment to Andy A for this purpose.

## 501(c)(3) Not For Profit

Benefits to the club include increased sponsorship, donation and grant opportunities, and as a tax-exempt entity we could save hundreds, even thousands of dollars in sales tax. The club will hire an accountant to handle the necessary paperwork and taxes. This will require the existing club to disband and a new organization to be created, as the current club is well past the window for applying for 501(c)(3). We could rename to Southern Kettle Moraine Horse Trails Association, to keep the website, email, etc the same. Barb L is contacting the accountant for more information and next steps to move forward.
