Maureen was a former member of the National Team in Canada, with international competitive experience. In 1979, Maureen opened Upstate Gymnastics, the third private gym in South Carolina, which is still open today. She opened the door for helping SC advance in our gymnastic knowledge. Maureen was a great resource for our community and always willing to share her knowledge. She participated and helped with many SC training camps, always providing a helpful perspective. In addition, Maureen served on the SC USA Gymnastics Committee for two terms. Her team participated in numerous regional training camps and had national, eastern, regional qualifiers and college athletes. Maureen, also, was heavily involved in the hosting of three regionals in SC. She participated with the group presenting to Clemson University on why we should have gymnastics at Clemson and was a partner in the Tiger Paw Classic, an invitational promoting the idea of a gymnastics team in Clemson. By the SC USA Gymnastics Committee and her peers, Maureen was named SC Coach of the Year, twice. Maureen Williamson was a successful coach and true leader in our community.

Declaration Date - Monday, February 23, 2026

- An athlete may NOT drop back to a division/lower level in a competitive season AFTER the declaration date. SAC determines prior to the beginning of the competitive year, a designated "declaration" date for each level for this purpose. The highest level / division competed at a sanctioned competition after the "declaration" date will determine the program (Dev / Xcel) for which the athlete can compete for the remainder of that season.

Policy for Clubs in Good Standing for SC

The benefits and requirements of Clubs in Good Standing are as follows: SC Clubs, including Coaches and Athletes in Good Standing:

- Are able to participate in Team Awards at State Championships
- Are able to attend Training Camps
- Are able to host SC Championships
- Are Able to attend SC Educational events, including SC Congress
- Will receive complimentary coaches' apparel (as designated by the SC SAC for coaches who have regional
 qualifiers), which is required to be worn at Regionals.

Currently, for a SC Club to be in "Good Standing", the following fees must be fully paid to SC:

Tracking Fees, Invitational Competition Fees, State Championship Entry Fee, SC Congress Registration Fee, SC Awards Ceremony Ticket Fee, SC Training Camps, Regional Non-Registration Fee, Regional No Show Fee

SC Invitationals & Calendar

- ► All SC Meets listed on the calendar will be considered Qualifying Meets for state meets! If your meet is listed as a qualifier you must adhere to the following guidelines:
- 1. Be held in the state of SC
- 2. Be open to any gym in SC
- 3. Pay \$2.00 Competition Fee per gymnast to SC USAG (cap of \$2,500 per meet)
- 4. Adhere to the following in regards to judges:
 - a. For all levels, athletes must be judged by properly rated officials and an unaffiliated Chief Judge on each event
 - b. One judge is allowed at Level 1-3, Bronze & Silver, this information must be included in the Pre-Meet information.
 - c. Two judges are required for Levels 4-10, Gold, Platinum, Diamond & Sapphire
- Out-of-state meets may be placed on the SC Calendar, as long as individuals overseeing the meet are associated with a SC club.

Entry Fees

Levels 8-10 - \$115 All other Levels - \$100 Event Specialist - Same entry fee as Level competing

Qualifying Scores for State Championships

- -Levels 1 and 2 Must participate in at least one USA Gymnastics qualifying competition prior to State Championship
- -All Other Levels 32.0 All Around 8.5 per event for Specialists for Levels 8-10, Xcel Platinum, Diamond & Sapphire
- Number of Judges

Levels 8-10 - 4 judges per event All other Levels - 2 judges per event

SC SAC policy states if a gymnast changes from one team to another team. This gymnast must re-qualify for that State Meet under the new team. If she does not do this or she changes teams too close to the State Meet to re-qualify, then the gymnast is allowed to compete at that State Meet but her scores will not count towards her new gym's team scores.





2025-2026 Rules & Policies 2025-2026 Development Program Update 2025-2026 Xcel Program Update 2025 Committee Meeting Minutes

The 2025-2026 Operating Code will be updated on the website once completed.

The SC SAC will touch on a few updates in this presentation, yet we strongly encourage you to review <u>ALL</u> the updates and minutes for the 2025-2026 season as there are many significant changes that you need to be aware <u>beyond</u> the updates discussed today.

General Updates Applicable to both Development & XCEL Programs

- ► BEGINNING IN 2026, USA GYMNASTICS IS TRANSITIONING TO A DIGITAL ONLY E-BOOK FORMAT FOR ALL WAG MATERIALS.
- Any private club or contracted photographer/videographer must have an agreement with the Meet Director and is not permitted to hold a dual role (e.g., coach and photographer) while present on the field of play.
- ► Acceptable Athlete Attire Sports bra, with exposed straps, may be black, match the leotard, be the athlete's skin tone, or clear in color.
- Meet Directors must notify clubs of any rotation or session splits prior to the competition start date to help prevent scheduling conflicts and to allow time for clubs to add additional coaches to RULES & POLICIES the sanction if needed.
- ▶ At all sanctioned events: if a Level 9 and/or Level 10 squad has fewer than five athletes (i.e., four or fewer) on Uneven Bars due to onsite scratches or unforeseen circumstances, an additional 2½-minute timed warmup may be provided. This additional warm-up time must include bar settings.

General Updates Continued Applicable to both Development & XCEL Programs

- ► If available on an event An alternate skill cushion made of softer foam is allowed to be used in warm-ups at all sanctioned competitions.
- ► Springboard on the vaulting table is PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES (including during open stretch and warm-up periods). The Meet Director is responsible for enforcing this rule.
- ▶ If the bar cable tension slips while an athlete is competing (after the coach has tightened the tension prior to the start of the routine), it is considered equipment failure. The 0.50 Fall deduction would not apply.
- ► If the Balance Beam end cap detaches WHILE AN ATHLETE IS IN THE PROCESS OF A DISMOUNT, it is considered equipment failure. The 0.50 Fall deduction WOULD NOT APPLY.
 - The end cap falling off during any other point in the athlete's routine would not be considered equipment failure.
- For competitions held in outside facilities: Beam dismount matting requirements to include a minimum of 4 feet by 4 feet of padding between the end of the Beam and the under-Beam matting. This padding may consist of panel mats, carpet-bonded foam, or similar materials.

General Updates Continued Applicable to both Development & XCEL Programs

- ► At all sanctioned competitions: TWO (2) 4-INCH MATS WILL BE ALLOWED (replacing the previous allowance of one (1) 4-inch mat and one (1) 8-inch mat).
 - The two (2) 4-inch mats may be stacked to achieve previous 8-inch allowance.
- ► All matting must be in place PRIOR TO THE START OF THE ROUTINE AND CANNOT BE ADDED ONCE THE ROUTINE HAS STARTED.
 - A 0.30 unauthorized use of matting deduction will be applied if matting is added after the exercise has begun.
- Mats may be removed during a routine only if taken from the nearest boundary line. The person removing the matting should stay outside the floor area as much as possible. Briefly stepping inside the border marking to remove mats will not result in a deduction
- ► The current music approval process is in effect for the 2025-26 season.
- \blacktriangleright Absence of music or music with words or song/speech deduction is now <u>0.50</u>.
- ► If the Level 6-10 Bars, Beam, Floor & Xcel Bars & Beam 0.30 DEDUCTION for No Dismount is NO LONGER APPLICABLE

NEW PETITION REQUIREMENT

Petition to Re-Enter the Development Program:

❖ Any athlete who has prior competitive experience in the Development Program and then competes in a State meet under an alternative program (e.g., Xcel or another gymnastics organization) must submit a petition to re-enter the Development Program at Level 5 or higher.

Levels 5-8: Petitions must be submitted to the SAC.

Levels 9-10: Petitions must be submitted to the RAC.

Compulsory Updates

Level 5 Bar Dismount

There is no longer a deduction of up to the value of the element of a Flyaway in tuck, pike, or layout position for the Level 5 bar dismount.

• Deduct 0.50 for the spot (in addition to any applicable execution errors).

Levels 1-5 Beam

CLARIFICATION ON ARM PLACEMENT - Place both hands shoulder-width apart on the beam (left hand can be straight or sideways) and jump to a FRONT SUPPORT to finish with arms straight and body extended.

Level 3 Back Roll on Floor

- 1. Performs a backward roll to handstand: Deduction 0.20
- 2. Remove requirement of reaching 45° above horizontal and update to: ABOVE HORIZONTAL BUT NOT REACHING VERTICAL.

XCEL UPDATES

XCEL CODE OF POINTS EXTENDED TO 2028

- * XCEL National Competition in the works, stay tuned for more information!
- ***** AT ALL XCEL COMPETITIONS:
- A two (2) judge panel is required at the Platinum, Diamond, and Sapphire Divisions for all mobility and qualifying meets.
- In SC Gold athletes must be judged by 2 judges to qualify to State Championships.
- A one (1) judge panel may be used for mobility at Bronze, Silver, and Gold.
- * Review the updated vault values for many vaults in the Platinum, Diamond & Sapphire Divisions.
- ❖ New Elements on Bars:
 - #8.008 Silver Only "A" From LB sole circle backward (tucked, piked, or straddle), circle around the bar 3/4(270°), with release dismount to stand
 - #8.009 Gold & Platinum Only "A" From HB sole circle backward (piked or straddle), circle around the bar 3/4(270°), with release dismount to stand

XCEL UPDATES CONTINUED

- New Elements on Bars Continued
 - #8.010 Gold, Platinum, Diamond, Sapphire "A" From HB cast stoop through or swing forward back kip-up to brief rear support (touching HB with back of thighs), salto backward tucked, piked, or stretched.
- ❖ After a fall judging resumes with the first element/value part allowed and performed at their division.
- ❖ Modify the Sapphire special requirement on Beam: Acro series with a minimum of one (1) flight skill (a minimum of one (1) skill must pass through or achieve vertical or be a salto or aerial).
- ❖ Floor Variations of elements #4.101 and FLOOR #4.102 are all considered different elements.

OPTIONAL UPDATES

▶ Vault:

- ➤ The sting mat MAY BE INCLUDED as an allowable component in the configuration of the Level 6/7 Vault Mat Stack to meet the required height (matting must be equal to or higher than the underside of the top of the vault table).
- ► Levels 8-10 may use the Vault table at any manufacturer setting, with a maximum of 135 cm (+ 1 cm).

▶ Uneven Bars:

- ► Stalder forward to handstand with 1/1 turn on one arm after handstand phase (Healy technique) to L or mixed-L grip value raised to a D (6.401).
- ► One single bar release (minimum of D) added to the Choice of Elements composition options for Level 9/10 bar routines.

▶ Beam:

► Element 2.501 (E) has been added to the Code of Points. From side stand Ring Jump (rear leg at head height) with ½ turn (180°) (Pennucci).

► Floor:

Review updated compositional deductions for acro saltos not up to the competitive level.
