## AM RICAMS KNOWN TO BE STILL IN VIETNAM AS OF DEC. 10, 1975

- 1. RICHARD M. (MIKE) MIELKE--Volunteer worker for Voices in Vital
  America (VIVA), Los Angeles-based POW-MIA
  group. Retired Special Forces and U.S.
  government employe.
- 2. MISTY 3. MIELKE -- Naturalized wife of Mielke.
- 3. IADALENE K. T. MIELKE -- 2 years old
- 4. LEONARD D. JUDSON -- Retired man, was living in Da Nang. Left there voluntarily in August, believing he would leave VN. Name scrubbed from two subsequent flights. Has been living at International Red Cross (IRC) compound. Has severe cataract problems and is legally blind.
- 5. FREDERICK GULD\_N -- USAID contract architect, Bangkok based. Missed evacuation while aiding employes to boats.
- 6. FRED RIVERA -- Contract aircraft mainetnance man for Lear-Siegler.

  Was based at BienHoa. Says he missed evacuation because didm't realize things were falling apart so quickly.

  Latest reported address hiramar Hotel, where he has (as of Nov. 25) no money to pay his bill.
- 7. FORD THOMAGEN -- Contract worker with FLC. Missed evacuation because he was in Dalta either a) trying rescue employes or b) trying to blow up commo sites, he says. Last known address with Vietnamese woman at 3, Tu Do.
- 3. Sterling H. Bennett -- Released from Saigon jail April 27, remained in Saigon.
- 9. JERRY POSNER -- ex-GI, Brookkyn, N.Y., postal employe, attempting to marry fiancee.
- 10. WILLIAM SMITH -- ex-GI, employer of Trailways or Grephound in Chicago. Stranded while attempting to find former sweetheart apprently in Da Man: area. Residing with Posner.
- 11. MICHAEL BAILEY -- 4 years old, U.S. pasaport holder, son of man now in Utah, and Vietnamese mother. Pasaport issued in Saigon and has never been out of VN.
- 12. JOSEPH BRICKMAN -- tour operator, owner of Vietnam Tourist Bureau, which he now running as fee-sponsored Foreigners' Club. Brickman claims dual citizenship (Britishborn, U.S. naturalized) but exploys U.S. passport.
- 13. CLIFFORD RANDOLPH -- Retired former contract workers. Garbled story tells how he missed evacuation due confused sitn aroundTan Son ZNHut, but confusion apparently was mostly hit.
- 14. JOSE RIOS -- Claims to be former Major of Lt. Col, USAF. Peurto Rican-born, magried to VN citizen.
- 15. KELRY TUBECK -- former CARE voluntuer. His wife, VN citizen, resides with him. She is the sister of the wife of Paul Struharik.

- 16. FRANCES STARNER -- noneworking, "friendly" journalist and the only known American journalist known to be in SVII.

  Claims Pacific News Service affiliation.
- 17. HERMAN McDOWALD -- Released from jail in Saigon April 27, and left saying he was going to Xuan Loc. Pelieved detained there since "liberation."
- 13. GUGELMAN (?) -- Mystery man in Baigon, believed to be U.J. government employe. Seen by several other Americans. Believed under detention in Baigon, likely at the Chi Hoa prison compound.
- 19. TERESA ROED -- Believed to be a num or religous worker. Hame first showed on a flight manifest in mid-August. Scrubbed from flight with 4 other Americans, although she showed at planeside. Described by witnesses as young, plain American woman, Caucaisian. Did not associate with other Americans.
- 20. Y.L. CHING -- Native of Hawaii, tear-gassed by Marines as he tried to board helicopters, apparently because of his Oriental features. Had stayed in Embassy 3 days prior to evacuation. Has another "wife in Philippones. A Singapore-based engineer, Ching says he spent 23 years with U.3. Navy as merchant seaman.
- 21. FAUL NORTON -- Living at Bien Hoa mental hospital and believed to be an in-patient.
- 2. FONG FILLER -- Legally adopted and naturalized American son of Lt. Col. Charles L. Filler, Newport News, VA. Married to (after "liberation") VN citizen, a clerk at the Saigon post office.
- 23. MIKYO MAI-LAN -- Vietnamese artist (painter), female. Presumably American by naturalization.
- 24. RICHARD HUGHES -- Director of former Shoeshine Boys. Brother Tom exited Vietnam in early August, before U.N. vote.
- 25. FAX EDIGER -- Mennonite workers, in VN voluntarily
- The addition, other naturalized Americans are sure to emerge. Among them are is a child, last name REAGAN, whose mother bears validentry papers as an alien to the U.B.
