ORDINANCE #1: TO APPROPRIATE SUMS OF MONEY

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING SUMS OF MONEY TO THE VARIOUS FUNDS AND SPENDING AGENCIES, IN THE AMOUNTS AND FOR THE PURPOSES AS SET FORTH BELOW, FOR THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO, FOR THE 1986 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Town of Marble has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on Jan 21, 1986 1986, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Marble has made provision therein for revenues in an amount equal to or greater than the total proposed expenditures as set forth in said budget, and;

WHEREAS, it is not only required by law, but also necessary to appropriate the revenues provided in the budget to and for the purposes described below, so as not to impair the operations of the Town District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the following sums are hereby appropriated from the revenue of each fund, to each fund, for the purposes stated:

General Fund	
Current Operating Expenses	\$ 19,226
Park Fund	
Current Operating Expenses	\$ 3,250
Revenue Sharing Fund	
Current Operating Expenses	\$ 2,500
