## **SUMMARY OBJECTIVE:**

The Bus Monitor is responsible for assisting the public transportation driver in the safe and timely delivery of the Head Start children, and for delivering assigned curriculum during transport.

- 5. Maintain confidentiality of all information regarding children, families and staff.
- 6. Attend all staff meetings, trainings, workshops and conferences in accordance with Head Start Performance Standards.
- 7. Complete all training as required.
- 8. Document at least 15 hours of in-service training annually in accordance with DCFS licensing standards.
- 9. Perform other duties and assist in other service areas as assigned.
