Cold Weather is on the way

Be sure to insulate your irrigation and backflow valves before the freezing temperatures arrive.

Protect exposed pipes by wrapping them in insulation or layers of newspaper and then covering them with plastic to keep out moisture. Turn off your outdoor sprinkler system during the freeze. Wrap or cover hose bibs and exposed elements of your sprinkler system such as irrigation boxes and valves. If freezing or near-freezing temperatures are forecast, run the water circulation system in your pool to prevent pipes from freezing. Cover exposed pool pipes. On the inside if your home has ceiling fans you can switch the blade rotation, counterclockwise in warm months and in winter switch the blades to clockwise on the lowest setting to keep you warmer.
