



## **To our Members and Guests**

**Biting is part of the natural behavior of ferrets. They may bite to get attention or as part of play. Sometimes ferrets nip out of fear. Some bites, though, cannot be blamed on the ferret. A common “mistake” bite is on the nose. Because ferrets don't see well, they don't realize that your nose (or hands or feet) are part of you. Don't bring a ferret directly up to your face; when you do so, all the ferret sees is a giant human nose about to loom into their blind spot (right in front of their nose). An immediate reaction is to latch on to the intruding human nose and keep it out of the way.**

### **Please remember...**

- 1. Don't pick up someone else's ferret without their permission.**
- 2. Don't allow your ferrets to play with other ferrets in the show hall. Some ferrets don't get along with strangers.**
- 3. This is a busy day for the ferrets. They need their naps too!**
