RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 98

Sing to the LORD a new song, for He has done marvelous things.

READING FROM THE EPISTLES - 2 Thess. 2:1-5, 13-17

As to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to him, we beg you, brothers and sisters, not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as though from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord is already here. Let no one deceive you in any way; for that day will not come unless the rebellion comes first and the lawless one is revealed, the one destined for destruction. He opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, declaring himself to be God. Do you not remember that I told you these things when I was still with you? But we must always give thanks to God for you, brothers and sisters beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the first fruits for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and through belief in the truth. For this purpose he called you through our proclamation of the good news, so that you may obtain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. So then, brothers and sisters, stand firm and hold fast to the traditions that you were taught by us, either by word of mouth or by our letter. Now may our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and through grace gave us eternal comfort and good hope, comfort your hearts and strengthen them in every good work and word.

EPISTLE LESSON - *Ephesians 6:10-18*

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his power. Put on the whole Armor of God, so that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the Devil, for our struggle is not against enemies of blood and flesh, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers of this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole *Armor of God*, so that you may be able to withstand on that evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. Stand therefore, and fasten the Belt of Truth around your waist, and put on the Breastplate of Righteousness. As shoes for your feet put on whatever will make you ready to proclaim the Gospel of Peace. With all of these, take the Shield of Faith, with which you will be able to quench all the flaming arrows of the evil one. Take the Helmet of Salvation, and the Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God. Pray in the Spirit at all times in every prayer and supplication; to that end keep alert and always persevere in supplication for all the saints.

CONFession OF FAITH

{from Westminster}

It pleased God, in His eternal purpose, to choose and ordain the Lord Jesus, His only begotten Son, to be the Mediator between God and humanity, the Prophet, Priest, and King; the Head and Savior of His

Church, the Heir of all things, and Judge of the world; for whom He did, from all eternity, give a people to be His seed, and to be by Him in time redeemed, called, justified, sanctified, and glorified. The Son of God, the Second Person in the Trinity, [did] take upon Him human nature...yet without sin: conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit, with the Virgin Mary...so that two whole, perfect, and distinct natures, the divinity and the humanity, were inseparably joined together in one person, without conversion, composition, or confusion...very God and very Man, yet one Christ, the only Mediator between God and humanity. The Lord Jesus in His human nature was thus united to the Divine, sanctified and anointed with the Holy Spirit with all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge, to the end that...He might be thoroughly equipped to execute the office of a mediator and surety. He...was called into this by His Father, Who put all power and judgment into His hand.
