The Yard-of-the Month winner for September 2018 is 2205 Pintail Drive, belonging to Chuck and Wendy Epperson. Their landscaping is highlighted by large rocks in different sizes, shapes and colors as well as an assortment of plants and flowers. The yard is neat and well maintained. The right side of the driveway, is bordered by a variety of flowers including Phlox, Black-Eyed Susan, Daisey, Rose, Aster, and a Hydrangea that was added this Spring. The top of the yard along the walkway that leads to the back yard is lined with Daylily, Daisey, Purple Coneflower, Iris & Rose. The right side of the lawn has a rock border & a variety of plants and groundcover such as Virginia Creeper and Larkspurleaf Tickseed along with a nice fragrant Lavender mound. The large, eye-catching Spruce tree is the highlight of the smaller portion of the yard on the left of the driveway. The grass is thick and deep green in color with a thick thatch as a result of mulching the cut grass as opposed to bagging it. Epperson's have spent a fair amount of time and effort this year combating lawn fungus. Their efforts have paid off. They find limited watering (three days each week) in the early morning hours works best. Wendy loves to work outdoors in the yard, and Chuck acknowledges that she does the majority of the vardwork.
