Energy Saving Opportunities for Winter Electricity Efficiency

As winter brings colder days, electricity demand tends to rise. To help reduce energy consumption and costs, here are some effective ways to save electricity without sacrificing comfort.

Seal Drafts and Insulate

Prevent heat loss by sealing gaps around windows and doors with caulking or weatherstripping. Proper insulation in walls and attics also keeps your home warmer, reducing the need for electric heating.

Use Energy-Efficient Lighting

Switch to LED bulbs, which use significantly less electricity and last longer. Turn off lights in unused rooms and consider motion sensors to manage lighting efficiently.

Install a Programmable Thermostat

A programmable thermostat optimizes temperature settings based on your schedule. Lower the heat when you're not home or asleep to reduce energy use.

Maximize Natural Light and Heat

Open curtains on sunny days to warm rooms naturally and close them at night for insulation. This simple approach minimizes reliance on electric heating.

Maintain Your Heating Systems

Regularly clean or replace filters in electric heating systems to ensure they work efficiently, using less electricity.

Upgrade to Energy-Efficient Appliances

Energy Efficient appliances use less electricity and reduce overall consumption, especially during winter when they're heavily used.

Use Smart Power Strips

Prevent "phantom" power draw from electronics by using smart power strips, which shut off devices when not in use.

Efficiently Manage Hot Water Use

Set your water heater to 120°F and consider low-flow showerheads to reduce electricity used for heating water.

Unplug and Turn Off

Unplug space heaters, electric blankets, and chargers when not in use to prevent unnecessary electricity use.

Be Safe On The Road In Winter

Regulated Rate Option (RRO)

The RRO rate may increase or decrease from month to month as it is priced on the open market and subject to many factors relating to supply and demand. If you do not have a contract with an electricity retailer, then you receive the default RRO rate.

For October 2024, the RRO is priced at \$0.11766 per kWh, which is reflected on your enclosed bill. For November 2024, the Battle River Power Coop monthly RRO billing rate for FENN REA members is \$0.11556. The RRO rate is also listed on www.fennrea.com.
