CHARACTER OF THE JOB:

This job involves a variety of work in the general maintenance and repair of buildings, facilities, and equipment. Limited use of electrical, carpentry, plumbing and general cleaning skills both indoors and outdoors on a day-today basis and to support the needs of the agency's vehicles for minor upkeep and general maintenance as required.

ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK:

(These examples do not list all the duties which may be assigned; any one position may not include all duties listed)

- 1. Electrical: Performs basic electrical installation and repair work in wiring for switches, outlets, plugs, cables, power circuits and appliances; repair lighting systems; inspects electrical systems for unsafe conditions.
- 2. Carpentry: To do repair work on furniture, doors, windows, etc. including painting varnishing as necessary.
- 3. Plumbing: Identifies and performs basic repairs of plumbing leaks or breaks; opens clogged lines and drains; replaces washers and other minor part.
- 4. Ground Maintenance: Maintains yard by keeping the grass at a presentable length, remove shrubs and plants that may obstruct, endanger or cause injury to others, and maintains grounds maintenance equipment.
- 5. Vehicle Maintenance: Responsible for maintaining organizations vehicle(s), changing tires, monitor oil, wash/vacuum company vehicle(s), and provide minor repairs.



- 6. Tool/Equipment Inventory: Maintains inventory of maintenance tools and equipment while making periodic recommendation for replacement.
- 7. Transporting: To assist with the transporting of supplies, office equipment, donations and other items to and from the shelters.
- 8. Respond appropriately to emergency and situations at the shelter and notifies Shelter Manager/Program Manager immediately.
- 9. Maintains building and grounds in clean and orderly condition.
- 10. Performs other related duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Physical requirements to be perform that may include stooping, standing, stretching and kneeling. Able to carry and lift tools and/or other implements required up to 30 pounds.

High School Diploma or GED equivalent, 2 years in working as a general repair, carpentry shop or mechanic skills or any combination of the above.

2. Valid Driver's License.
