Regular Meeting ----- July 23, 1992

The meeting was called to order by the Vice- ATTENDANCE Chairman, Gary N. Wilson at 7:10 A.M. at the District office. Other Board members present were Karl Tangren, David Maki, and James Walker.

Special Service District members present were George White, Gary Wilson, and Bill McDougald.

Others present were David Adkison, Marsha Modine, Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of June MINUTES 11, 1992. George moved to approve the minutes as read. Karl seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

David Adkison presented the 1991 GCWCD audit GCWCD AUDIT report, stating it had been a smooth audit and a quiet year. Adkison suggested the letter to local contractors might go out twice a year instead of once, and that a written policy be put into place regarding purchases. James Walker moved to accept the 1991 audit report. Karl seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Adkison then presented the GCSSWD 1991 audit GCSSWD AUDIT report in the same fashion. Bill moved to accept the 1991 audit report. George seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Dale reported the MIC had formally requested an ADVANCE PAYadvance payment. He consulted Brent Rose, who stated that MENT TO MOAB in his opinion this advance would be defined as a loan and IRRIGATION was allowed by law. Walker asked Adkison his opinion, who co. suggested the interest be deducted from the advance. Karl moved the advance be made, with interest credit based on the PTIF monthly rate. George seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Marsha stated that the tax rate according to the GCWCD TAX RATE rules governing the setting of tax rates, the GCWCD rate for Grand County will be M&O .000051, debt service .000214, total .000265, and for San Juan County, M & 0 .000050, debt service .000237, total .000287. James Walker moved to set the rate for GCWCD for Grand County at .000265 and for San Juan County at .000287. Karl seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Marsha stated that according to the rules the GCSSWD TAX RAT GCSSWD rate for Grand County should be .000511 for debt service and for San Juan County at .000565. Bill moved to set the total tax for GCSSWD be set at .000511 for Grand County and at .000565 for San Juan County. George seconded. MO-TION CARRIED.

Dale presented the final plans of the George White GEORGE WHITE Well #5 project and stated these plans have been presented WELL #5 INTER to the Health Dept. David Ariotti, S.E. Utah Health Dis- CONNECT trict Engineer, has written the District a letter suggesting a specified pitless adapter be included in the plans, and has also asked the District to include a sampling tap, check valve and pressure gauge. The vent on the air vac valve must extend 12 inches above grade, with a marking pole to prevent damage. After a question Pierson said \$38,500.00 is the total estimated cost of the project.

Clean up at the lake was discussed, and Gary sug- PERMANENT gested looking again at permanent toilets at the lake.
