## Looking back at the last four months:

- Sunday worship was streamed on Facebook with only three in-person services. "Communion in Cars" was begun monthly to allow members to receive the sacrament in the safety of vehicles.
- Our high school graduates were honored with quilts and prayer books on June 14th.
- At the end of May, Michele Pokluda resigned from her part-time work in the church office to begin a full-time position elsewhere. Her office position will remain open for the time being.
- Our congregation became a collaborative learning site for Wartburg Seminary. We welcomed Daniel Volkmann and his wife Mallory on July 12. Daniel began his four year program of working on our staff for 25 hours a week and attending seminary through online classes.
- The monthly newsletter was replaced by a weekly email publication in order to keep our members better informed amidst rapid changes. This is sent to those close to Shiner. Let the office know if you want to be included. A few members who do not have email receive a print copy.
- Volunteers worked to plant and to maintain the lawn and landscape. It now looks great.
- The sink area of the kitchen was cleared. New sinks, counters, and cabinets are being installed.
- Despite postponements and cancellations of our fellowship and ministry events, the pastor, staff and volunteers worked to continue an online worship presence, maintain our facility, and care for our members as best we could within the limitations of the pandemic guidelines.
