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5. Bug Club – choose a book that looks interesting to you. Read through it and don't forget to answer the comprehension questions as they appear.

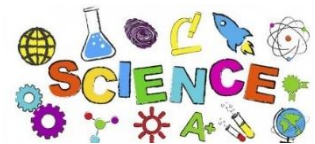


History
