


MASS RESERVATIONS

ALL SOULS DAY Monday, November 2



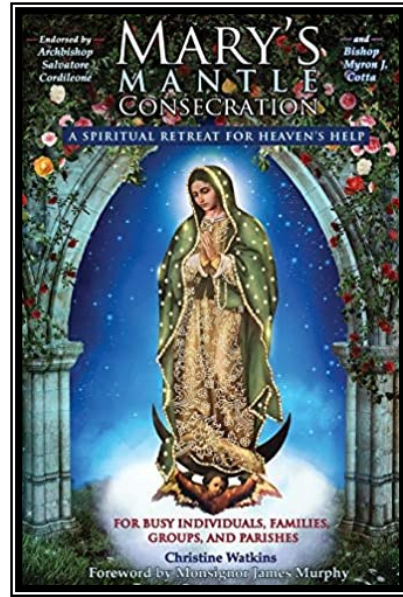

While we have the great pleasure of having musical accompaniment at our weekend Masses now, please don't "sing along". The ever present COVID restrictions for our church preclude singing as it can

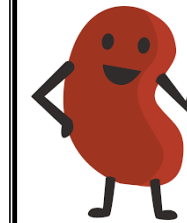
spread the infection to others. While we can't sing with our lips we can still sing with our hearts.
