The judges tasted each of the wines beginning with the whites, followed by the reds, based on the following criteria: scent, clarity, and taste. Ranking each wine from 1 to 5 (5 being the best). Once the judging was complete, the score cards were tallied and the winners determined.



On Saturday, January 28th, many teachers and šola parents attended VIRTUS training. VIRTUS is a program required by




