
Hot Dogs

- Cincinnati Style Coney Dog: Grilled hot dog topped with a mild Mediterranean-spiced finely ground meat sauce developed by immigrant restaurateurs in the 1920s, a heap of grated cheddar cheese, and diced white onions
- California Style BLT Dog: Grilled hot dog topped with a strip of crispy bacon, diced tomatoes, shredded lettuce, and mayonnaise
