The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, Gary N. Wilson at 7:00 A.M. ATTENDANCE at the District office. Other Board members present were Bill McDougald, Ned Dalton, John Groo and James Walker.

Special Service District members present were Dan Holyoak, George White, Bill McDougald, Kevin Johnson and Gary Wilson.

Others present were Dale Pierson, Jolyne Hoffmann, Marsha Modine and John Ogden.

After calling for additions or corrections to the minutes of the meeting of MINUTES November 6 .1997, and hearing none, the Chair declared the minutes approved as APPROVAL circulated to the Board. Motion: Bill Seconded: Dan MOTION CARRIED

CHECK APPROVE

MAINTENANCE CONTRACT: The Board was presented with a revised copy of the DISTRICT maintenance Contract. Dale said changes were made to the wording based on MAINTENANCE feedback from Attorney Steve Russell. Ned was concerned that paragraph one would CONTRACT allow a contract to be awarded before a license was received. Dale said the license will be requested with the contractor's bid. George moved to approve the maintenance contract and John seconded. MOTION CARRIED

RIVER WATER LEASE AGREEMENT: A draft of the Colorado River Water Lease RIVER WATER Agreement was reviewed by the Board. Dale said the Division of Drinking Water will LEASE not approve the terms of a lease for culinary water to a development unless the lease is AGREEMENT perpetual. Kevin felt the reference to 'perpetual' was not essential in item 3 since item 1 states that the diversion of water to the Developer will be allowed so long as the Conservancy District has water available to it from the Colorado River. Dan motioned to lease John Ogden 20 AF of Colorado River water at \$20/AF contingent on review of the lease agreement by attorney Brent Rose and final review by this Board. Bill seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED Mr. Ogden mentioned that he would still like the Board to consider leasing water for irrigation purposes.

ITEMS FROM BOARD MEMBERS: The Board was reminded that a joint meeting is BUDGET JOINT scheduled for December 1st at 4:00 p.m. to discuss common issues on the budget. WORK SESSION Insurance costs with ULGT for 1998 were raised by 19%. Gary said he asked staff to provide quotes for the December 1st meeting from other insurance companies to try to reduce this cost.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Board was presented with an October 1997 Financial FINANCIAL Statement for their review.

Dale reported on the Mill Creek Partnership meeting. ITEMS FROM STAFF: Partnership is concerned with the quality of water flowing through the canyon and WATER would like to limit the use of Mill Creek. The BLM is requesting GCWCD sponsor the RECLASSIFICAT: reclassification of water for Mill Creek and tributaries, from confluence with Colorado River to headwaters. The Board felt Moab City should also be involved. Dale said he would determine if there would be costs associated with the reclassification and report back to the Board.

The MILL CREEK

Dale said the Extension Service is in the process of planning an Irrigation seminar for IRRIGATION February or March. Board members should call the Extension Service directly with SEMINAR items they would like discussed at the seminar. James said he would like to see two sessions planned; one for farmers and one for small lots.
