RESPONSIVE READING - Psalm 14

The fool in his heart has said, "There is no God."

**They are corrupt, they have done abominable deeds;
there is none who does good.**

The LORD looks down from Heaven on humankind
to see if there are any who understand, who seek God.

**They have turned aside, they have become corrupt together
there is none who does good; no, not [even] one.**

Have they no knowledge, all the evildoers who eat up My people
as they eat bread and do not call upon the LORD?

**There they shall be in great terror,
for God is with the generation of the righteous.**

You shame the counsel of the poor, but the LORD is their refuge.

**O that deliverance for Israel would come from Zion!
When the LORD brings back His people [from] the captivity,
let Jacob rejoice [and] Israel be glad.**

TORAH READING - Exodus 32:7-14

The LORD said to Moses, "Go down at once! Your people, whom you brought up out of the land of Egypt, *[for]* they have corrupted *[themselves]*. They have turned aside quickly out of the Way which I commanded them; they themselves have made a molded calf and have worshiped it and sacrificed to it and said, 'These *[are]* your gods, O Israel, that brought you out of the land of Egypt!'" The LORD said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and indeed it is a stiff-necked people. Now, therefore, let Me alone, so that My wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them; and I will make of you a great nation." But Moses pleaded with the LORD his God, and said, "LORD, why does Your wrath burn hot against Your people, whom You brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? Why should the Egyptians say, 'He brought them out to kill them in the mountains and to consume them from the face of the Earth'? Turn from Your fierce wrath and relent *[from]* Your this harm to Your people. Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, Your servants, to whom You swore to them by Your own self and said to them, 'I will multiply your descendants like the stars of Heaven and all this land that I have promised I will give to your descendants and they shall inherit it forever.'" So he LORD relented from the harm which He said He would do to His people.

GOSPEL LESSON - Luke 15.1-10

All the tax collectors and sinners were drawing near to hear *[Jesus]* and both the Pharisees and the Scribes were grumbling and saying, "This *[man]* welcomes sinners and eats with them." *[Jesus]* told them this parable, saying: "Which one of you, having a hundred sheep and having lost one of them, *[does]* not leave the ninety-nine in the open field and goes after the one having been lost until he finds it? And, having found it, he lays it on his shoulders rejoicing. And having come home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying to them, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found my sheep that was lost'. I say to you, in the same way there will be joy in Heaven over one sinner repenting rather than over *[the]* ninety-nine righteous persons who have no need of repentance. "Or, what woman, having ten drachmas, if she should lose one drachma, does not light a lamp, sweep the house and

search carefully until she finds it? And having found it, she calls together the friends and neighbours, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the drachma that I lost.' Thus, I say to you, there is joy before the angels of God over one sinner repenting."

This is the Word of the Lord!

CONFESSTION OF FAITH from The Heidelberg Catechism

What is your only comfort, in life and in death?

That I belong—body and soul, in life and in death—not to myself but to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ, Who at the cost of His own blood has fully paid for all my sins and has completely freed me from the dominion of the devil; that He protects me so well that without the Will of my Father in Heaven not a hair can fall from my head; indeed, that everything must fit His purpose for my salvation. Therefore, by His Holy Spirit, He also assures me of eternal life and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for Him.

What, then, must a Christian believe?

We must all believe what is promised us in the Gospel, a summary of which is taught us in the articles of the Apostles' Creed, our universally acknowledged *Confession of Faith*.

What is true faith?

True Faith is not only a certain knowledge by which I accept as true all that God has revealed to us in His Word, but also a wholehearted trust which the Holy Spirit creates in me through the Gospel, that, not only to others, but to me also God has given the forgiveness of sins, everlasting righteousness and salvation, out of sheer grace solely due to Christ's saving work. **AMEN**
