POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOLLOWING THE REMOVAL OF A PILONIDAL SINUS

- 1. **KEEP THE RECTAL AREA CLEAN AND DRY**. After a bowel movement, clean your bottom with baby wipes. Then blot the area dry using white unscented to let paper. Always wipe forward, away from the operative wound; to help guard against cross contamination and infection.
- 2. **KEEP THE WOUND CLEAN AND DRY**. First spread Silvadene® creme liberally around inside the open pilonidal wound. Then, put an unfolded 4x4 gauze pad loosely into the opening. Then roll 3 or 4 4x4 gauze pads, and place them longitudinally over the pilonidal opening. Then, cover this area with several 4x4 gauze pads, and tape down using a hypo-aller genic surgical tape.

The dressing is to be changed nightly, or whenever it becomes soiled. It may be removed for bathing, but should be replaced immediately afterwards. If a rash from the surgical tape develops, notify the doctor.

MILK OF MAGNESIA®: To soften the stool and, gently stimulate a bowel movement, if constipation should develop.
