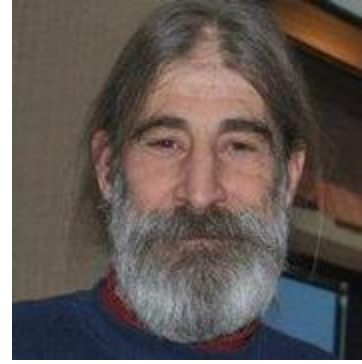


Kin L. Geilhart
