

This year, the Church celebrates the Jubilee of Hope. It is a special Holy Year to help us renew our trust in God, strengthen our faith, and live as people who bring hope to others.

The biblical *Jubilee* was a time of release, marked by freeing slaves, forgiving debts, and letting the land rest (cf. Leviticus 25). It was a time for new beginnings. The Church continues this tradition every twenty-five years, inviting us to start fresh, experience God's mercy, grow closer to Christ, and live our faith with new energy.


Pope Francis has chosen Hope as the theme for this Jubilee, which is something our world truly needs right now. Even when we face division, worry, or uncertainty, Christian hope stands strong. We believe that Christ is alive, that He is with us, and that His love will always win. As the *Letter to the Hebrews* says, hope is "a sure and steadfast anchor of the soul" (Heb 6:19).
