- Acts 10:34a, 37–43 Peter is an eyewitness: The Lord is risen.
- Psalm 118 “This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad.”
- Colossians 3:1–4 All who are baptized, set your hearts in heaven. or 1 Corinthians 5:6b–8 Christ our Passover is sacrificed: Out with the old, in with the new.

Happy Easter! Today we celebrate the most important day in the Church year—the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Our hearts are filled with joy because Jesus destroyed death forever and opened the gates of Paradise to the faithful, and to all people of good will. Over the last week we sat with Jesus at the Last Supper, we walked with him on the way to Calvary, we held vigil for him while in the tomb, and today we are lifted up with him in the glory of new life in his resurrection.
