#### MEMBERSHIP CORNER

Back when I first started dancing, I was given a lot of advice by several dancers. Several of them have truly stood out. One is to ... Dance with different people.

Over time I have discovered that simple piece of advice has multiple aspects. When first learning to dance, be it square dancing or round dancing, it is good to have a different partner. This helps ensure that you do the call/move correctly rather than the two of you doing it wrong but ending up right because of a mutual accommodation. It goes beyond that to the benefits of dancing with a different corner, dancing in a different square, dancing in a different location, dancing to different music, and dancing to different callers/cuers.

That variety helps you learn to dance with: people that are different in height, a square with a specific twist to a call, variations in lighting, acoustics, flooring, less obvious rhythms, accents, inflections, patterns, and pitch. Part of the joy in dancing is that it is never exactly the same twice. That exposure to variety tests and expands your abilities.

When I first started there were 5 local clubs, with 5 different callers, and 3 different cuers to dance with in 3 different locations. Those were a start, yet it was the special dances, like the Azalea Festival, Daffodil Festival, Fall Festival, and Conventions that truly broadened my experience. Thanks to the variety from one Convention to another, I couldn't help but learn how to have a uniquely great time from each different dance.

What does this have to do with Membership? VASARDA is primarily responsible for the Virginia Convention and assists with special dances and clubs. VASARDA needs the benefit of a large membership with lots of different people. The more people involved the greater the variety of ideas and the larger the variety of talents to draw from. The National convention primarily handles registration digitally. Many state Conventions are also either handling their registration digitally or they are moving toward digital registration. Making a shift to digital registration for the Virginia Convention requires upfront funds for setup. The result can be significant savings in volunteer hours and postage. That same setup can then be used for other special dances.

Are you willing to volunteer time to help make VASARDA successful? Contact your regional representative and they will help take advantage of your talents. Already a current VASARDA member, thank you. Don't have time to volunteer, consider making a donation to VASARDA to help pay administrative cost, or perhaps you want to help cover the carpet with wood flooring for the Convention. Not currently a VASARDA member? Please join today and help VASARDA continue to improve the events and experience for dancers in Virginia, and ultimately beyond.

We hope everyone is having a great summer. We had a wonderful Memorial Day Cookout and Square Dance. The weather was perfect and the food was good (photo from our event below).


